About the Rendezvous

The Rendezvous has been providing high quality help and support for young people (13-25) in need in Sherborne and the surrounding area for over 20 years. It is the only organization of this kind in the region and its core services are free and open to any young person no matter their background or where they live.

The Rendezvous team of youth workers, counsellors and volunteers listen, advise, support and teach over 350 young people every year making measurable differences to their lives. The team work in the centre through drop-in sessions and by appointment, and on the streets through outreach sessions, provide weekly one to one tutoring for English and Maths, and individual support and counselling in schools. They take referrals from the health visitor team for vulnerable young parents whom they visit in the home - our Young Parents Support Group has been running for nearly twenty years.

The organization is respected in the community and has strong partnerships with the local schools, health service and business community.

About the Friends

The Friends of the Rendezvous was originally set up over ten years ago, and helps to fill the funding hole left by cuts to statutory funding streams. It continues to provide an invaluable source of regular income for the charity, actively raising between £15,000-20,000 every year. The Friends makes regular payments towards the core costs of running the charity as well as occasional ex gratia payments towards specific items of expenditure to help young people in crisis.

How we raise funds:

- Friends membership contributions
- Weekly coffee mornings at the Rendezvous (Tuesday and Fridays 10am – 12noon)
- Events in the community – such as concerts and cake sales

We welcome people who would like to organize an event on our behalf – please get in touch with the Chair of the Friends.

Gift aid

If you join the Friends and pay income tax at the higher or additional rate there are benefits to you and the charity. You can receive additional tax relief on your donation but must include all Gift Aid donations on your self-assessment tax return or ask HMRC to adjust your code. We in turn receive an additional 25p from government for every pound donated.
