The impact on young people of lockdowns and disrupted education has been profound. With increased anxiety many have chosen to remain hidden at home becoming increasingly isolated and reluctant to take part. But, over the year we have continued to seek new ways to engage and help those who are struggling with ever more complex needs and make connections through our outreach programme. More than 80% of the work we now do is targeted one to one work with additional small nurture groups providing bridging support for young people to get into school, work, employment or volunteering.
